 En uno de nuestros ^{numeros} diarios se dijo, hace alg^o tiempo, que el Gob^o de B^o A^o ^{habia hecho p^{ro}vision a las yslas Malvinas, & habia segun ^{comunicacion} que son de la p^{ro}vincia de este pais. Vemos que esto es un hecho, y que el Gob^o de B^o A^o ha hecho donacion de la ysla Oriental de Malvinas a un espanol, llamado Veruet, en compensacion de reclamaciones que tenia pendientes contra ese Gob^o. Don Luis Veruet ha tomado posesion de esta ysla, de la qual se ha constituido Gobernador, y ha emitido un papel invitando a agricultores britanicos y otros a recibir de el terrenos. Un oficial muy respetable de la marina britanica ha comprado un terreno de 10 millas, y se espera que otros seguiran su exemplo. Por lo mismo, podra ser importante de observar, que D^o Luis Veruet no tiene orden a esta ysla. Estamos autorizados a decir, que nuestro Gob^o ~~ni~~ reconoce el caracter oficial de esta persona, ni el derecho del Gob^o de B^o A^o p^{ro} ejercer, o delegar a persona alg^ua a ejercer los poderes de Gob^o, o autoridad alg^ua en la yslas Malvinas, sobre las q^{ue}, al contrario S^o M^o. reclama y continue de asertar, su derecho de soberania"}

We noticed some time back the claim of the
B^y A^g Gov^t to the Falkl^d Isl^s; and it appears
by very recent advices that this claim is well
in. A sailing vessel (superior), which touched at
Port Louis for supplies, has been seized by Governor
(as he terms himself) Verrot, and the crew made prisoners.
They were treated with great inhumanity, and left with
but a scanty supply of provisions to subsist on.
They were ultimately sent to Rio Janeiro. An armed vessel
had also sailed from Port Louis in quest of another vessel
said to be amongst the Islands. The American Gov^t
was preparing to put a stop to these outrages. - Mor-
ning Herald. - (The Island under the authority of
Mr Verrot was purchased by him of the B^y A^g
Gov^t, the British Gov^t having previously refused
to purchase it, although it was declared to be highly
essential to us. Mr Verrot has since sold a portion
of his territory to a Lieutenant, and an English
Colony will, it is expected, be established.)
