Sir

I hand you herewith my authorisation to bring to this port the Sch^r Breakwater taking previously the following precautionary steps—

1st To secure the vessels papers and Log book

2^{dy} To put on an highland higher up the Bay, the officers and crew with abundance of provisions and their clothing & beds, as also a sail and spars for a tent—letting them know that I shall send for them one by one to ^{make} ~~tell~~ their Declaration.

3- For regularity sake you will leave on board one or two of the vessel men or officers.

4 you will communicate with me personally or by letter previous to coming round with the vessel to let me know the particulars of the same

Arrived 15 Aug in Salvador Bay

18 G^o was seized

20 D^o run away
