Sir



I have to acquaint you that I have received from the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty a despatch relative to the occupation of the Falkland Islands, wherein the following observations concerning you occur.

" With regard to Mr Veraco's claims,  
" as His Majesty's Government considered  
" these Islands to be a part of the  
" Dominions of the British Crown,  
" no claim of Property on his part  
" must be admitted, arising from a  
" Grant real or supposed of the  
" Buenos Ayres Government to him  
" of the Islands, or any claims of

"Fishing or other Seigneurial Right"  
"or to the possession of Wild Game"  
"or any other production of the Island".
