A 1^a Contrato Original de navegacion -

Harries

It is agreed upon between the prize master, seamen or mariners of the Schooner Harries of Strington seized for infringing the laws respecting the fisheries among these Islands of which Schooner is at present master Matthew Brisbane or whoever shall go for prize master now bound from Port Louis East Falkland Island to Port or Ports in Falkland Islands And Staten Land to receive some boats crews and to take off other property left in those places by said schooner and by the schooner Superior of New York likewise seized for the same reason which service said Schooner Harries does with the consent of the parties concerned and from thence to return to Port Louis and Buenos Ayres —

That in consideration of the monthly wages against each respective seaman or mariners name hereunder set they severally shall and will perform the upper mentioned voyage. And the said master does hereby agree with and hire the said seaman or mariners for the said voyage at such monthly wages to be paid pursuant to this agreement and they the said seamen or mariners do and hereby promise and oblige themselves to do their duty and obey the lawful command on board the said vessel or the boats therewith belonging as become good and faithful seamen or mariners and at all places where the said vessel shall put in or anchor at

during the said voyage to do their best endeavours for the preservation of the said vessel and cargo and not to neglect or refuse doing their duty by day or night nor shall go out of the said vessel or board any other vessel or be on shore under any pretence whatsoever until the above voyage be ended and the said vessel be discharged of her loading without leave first obtained of her captain or commanding officer on board that in default thereof he or they will be liable to forfeit their wages - And it is further agreed on that no officers or seamen belonging to the said vessel shall demand or be entitled to his wages or any part thereof until the arrival of the said vessel at the last above mentioned Port of delivery -

That for the due performance of each and every of the above mentioned articles and agreements and acknowledgments of their being voluntary and without compulsion or any other clandestine means being used, agreed to and signed by us -
