

Port Luis Sept 13th 1831.

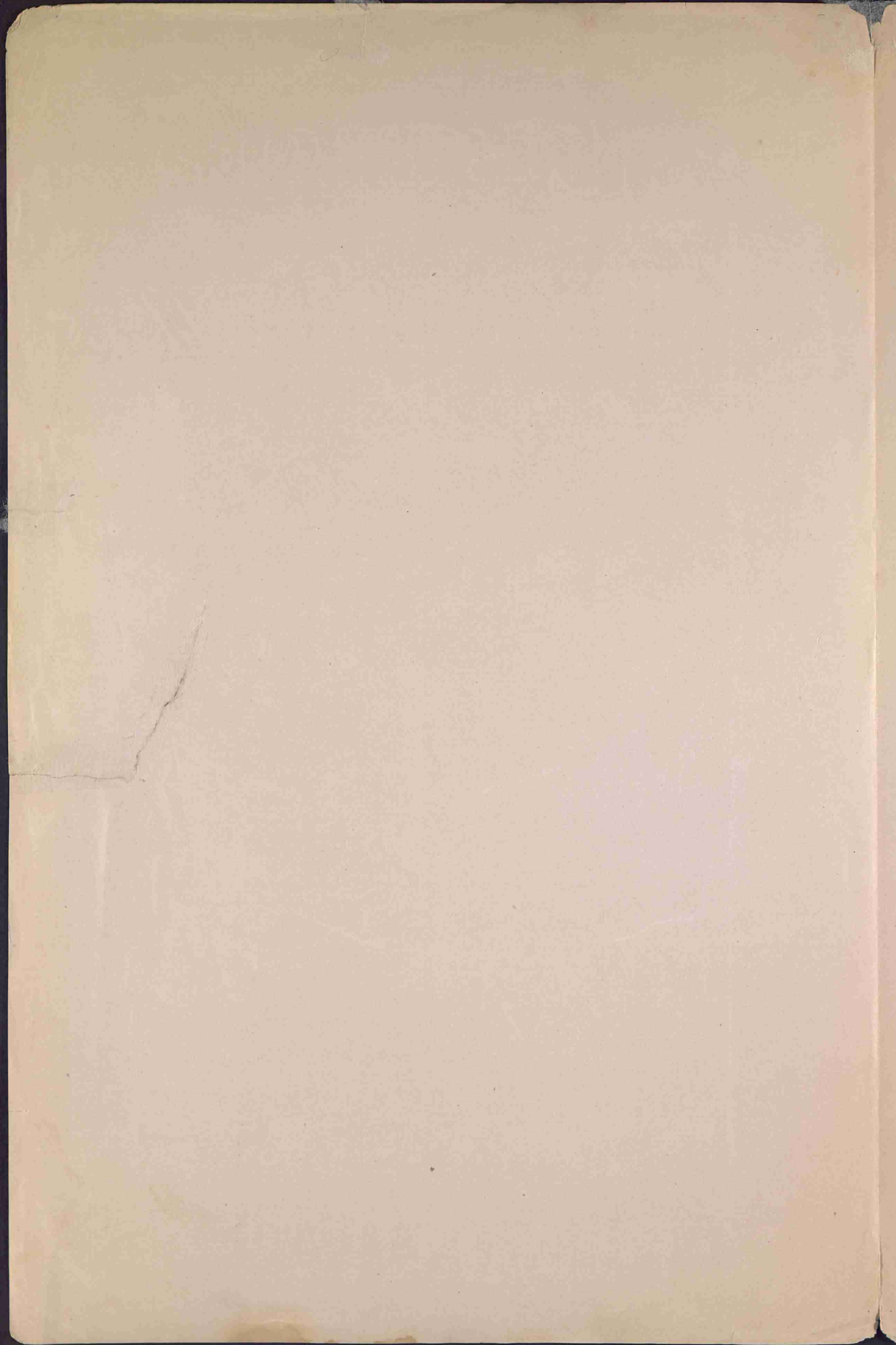
Mr Albertson,



92 ✓ Sir: The Sch Superior has been seized by Mr Luis Vernet Governor of the Falkland Is-les. For Sealing These Isles & The Sch Harriet Being seized also. Capt. Davison Myself & Mr Vernet has entered in to an agreement, or contract for the Superior to go Sealing on the West Coast to A. A. King discovered Sealing Ground, & the Sch Harriet to Proceed to Buenos Aires for Trial, & Both Vessels will know their Fate by the Sch Harriet's Trial; I am Bound Direct to the West Coast, & shall Be at Port Luis in the course of Six or eight months if Mr Vernet Sends to Staten Land for your Boat & Skins you had Better come to this place & Remain here untill I Return. Take a Receipt for your skins in the Name of the Sch. Superior as the Fate of the Sch will Decide wether They Belong to The Buenos Aires Government or to Silas L. Burrows -
