Bahia 27 October 1818



Sir

I am directed by my Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, to inform you in the most distinct manner that if you should persist in declining to remove your moveable property from the Falkland Islands, you must ascribe to yourself any deterioration which that property may sustain, and that under no circumstances will Sir Majesty's Government consent to become responsible for the preservation of such property, or for any damage which may be done to it.
