N.B. — I again draw your attention to the
absolute necessity, of not delaying an instant
" to confirm on me for ever all the Grants,
" Rights, Privileges & authorisations conferred,
" by your predecessor, & by him to me: "

Why I appear to be so earnest on that point
is to avoid the possibility of any obstacle
being raised against my delegated
power, the time, & so on (not that there
can be any in Law) now that I have
at last the Business, & my Plans in
good train: Besides, if there should be
any unavoidable delay in getting
the matter fully thro' Parliament this
Session, the time granted by you for
the settlement, will have elapsed, & that
at any rate, produce a check to the extent
which we desire to carry it: Also, our
Government who appear anxious to
possess the whole of the Islands will be

thus effectually defeated, as I have now, & shall
 have them, for ever the right to assign by
 Gift to you any quantity (which I hereby =
 = engage to do,) having already so legally
 arranged & secured all these matters here
 that it is actually as private property &
 privileges, to me; (prior to their taking
 any possession, &c.) which they cannot
 overthrow, tho' I fully expect they will
 be disposed to cooperate with me, & have
 such assistance, combined with our
 reciprocal aid & assiduity; your Welfare
 & ours, must be most beneficially pro=
 = moted. ? -
